
S&P 500 Volatility

- VIX is the most quoted volatility index in the world and is a consistent measure of expected volatility for the S&P 500 over the following 30 calendar days
- The VIX methodology uses options expiring just before and just after a 30-day time frame
- Some far OTM options may not be included in the calculation as there is a cut off after two 'no bid' options in a row

S&P 500 vs. VIX - Jan 3, 2023 – Jun 21, 2023






Nasdaq-100 Volatility

- The Nadaq-100 Volatility Index (VOLQ) measures expected 30-day volatility for the Nasdaq-100
- The VOLQ methodology uses at-the-money options expiring before and after the 30-day time frame

S&P 500 vs. Nasdaq 100 – 2022


SPX vs. NDX Dec 31, 2021 - Dec 30, 2022

SPX vs. NDX Dec 30, 2022 - Jun 21, 2023






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

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Index Futures Markets - Benefits

- Manage exposure to US equity market nearly 24 hours a day Sunday evening through Friday afternoon US time
- Ability to gain exposure to broad markets with small initial margin
- Dividends are implied in futures pricing
- No borrow needed to take short positions




